Among the many neighbors of Sea Lion Caves are the numerous Cormorants who can be seen diving for fish and tending their nests on the nearby steep and rocky cliffs.



Sea Lion Caves is an enthralling treat for nature enthusiasts of every age. Children will especially enjoy seeing wild Sea Lions cavort on the rocks just outside the cave.



Just passing through on their way both north and south, Grey Whales often swim close to shore and even spend time feeding in the area near Sea Lion Caves.



Another occasional tenant is the Pigeon Guillemot, a bird that spends much of its life living on the ocean, far from shore, landing here to nest and raise its young.



Speaking of cavorting, be certain to bring a camera for unique and memorable family photo opportunities - such as your kids climbing on the sea lion sculpture.



Take in the many wonderful scenic vistas, including the picturesque Heceta Head Lighthouse plainly visible just to the north of Sea Lion Caves.

Sea Lion CAVES

Formation of these marvelous caves began over 25 million years ago. The interior now soars to the height of a 12-story building and stretches the full length of a football field. Great care is taken to avoid disturbing these magnificent creatures or their habitat.

This is truly one of the most remarkable nature experiences you are likely to encounter anywhere. Here you are seeing these amazing creatures in their natural home. You are experiencing them where they have chosen to live. You share their world, and it's a "must see" for nature lovers of all ages.

The Stellar Sea Lion is a warm-blooded mammal which gives birth, nurses its young, and must breathe air. Sea Lion bulls, when fully grown, can weigh up to a ton. Since these sea lions are wild, they are unpredictable. They frequently make their home in the cave and/or the rock ledge just outside the cave. The tour starts at the main building and gift shop. It includes some stairs and an inclined pathway which leads to the elevator. The elevator carries you down 208 feet into the "world's largest sea cave."
